
Gender Pay Gap Report

Under the Equality Act 2010 (Gender pay Gap Information) Regulations 2017, Endeavour Academies Trust is required to publish information showing the difference in earnings of men and women employed by the Trust.

The gender pay gap is not the same as unequal pay.

Gender Pay Gap

On the snapshot date of 31 March 2023 there were 263 full-pay relevant employees.



The mean hourly rate for women was 12.48% lower than men.

The median hourly rate for women was 30.79% lower than men.

There is no difference in pay between male and female staff in the same role.

Endeavour Academies Trust does not make any bonus payments.

Reason for results

There are more women than men in our lower paid roles but there are also more women than men in higher paid ones. Women employed by the Trust are more evenly distributed across the 4 quartiles whereas although fewer men are employed by the Trust, a higher percentage of men are employed in the top quartile rather than the lower quartile.

In the most up to date figures published three quarters of teachers employed in England were female. This is also reflected nationally in the number of support staff who are female.
